## Abstract

Every year, the U.S. National Parks Service (NPS) compiles and releases a report on the previous year's visitor statistics. The NPS Social Science Program is tasked with coordinating and reporting these statistics. Program and park staff work together to collect, report, and provide this public data. This coordination ensures consistent, reliable information throughout every park in the U.S. National Park System.

This report is a detailed summary of recreational visits to parks in the U.S. National Park system in 2019. It describes the methods used to gather visitor data and the results of the data in terms of recreational visits by park, park type, and park location. In 2019, there were more recreational visits than in 2018, but not near as many visitors – 230 million -- as the park's centennial high-water mark set in 2016.

## Introduction

Since 1916, the National Park Service has worked to protect and preserve the cultural, historical, and natural gems of the American landscape. With their core mission being "to protect park resources and values and to provide for the enjoyment of parks by this and future generations", the NPS depends on reliable visitor information to ensure proper management. This good management depends on accurate *Visitor Use Statistics* including how many people visit at a time, what they do when visiting, how long they typically stay, and other characteristics of the typical visitor.

Visitor Use Statistics references the formal set of NPS statistics on the number of people visiting the parks and their length of stay. Typically, this set includes recreational visit counts, recreational visit hours, non-recreational visit counts, non-recreational visit hours, and overnight stays by category. This report only concerns recreational visit counts by park.

Recreational Visits (RVs) are the most tangible statistic for the NPS. A recreational visit "occurs when one person enters onto lands or waters administered by the NPS for any recreational purpose".

In 2019, the NPS recorded 327,516,619 recreational visits. Of the 419 national parks in the system, 378 parks recorded recreational visits.

While National Parks like Yellowstone and the Great Smoky Mountains illustrate the ideal park for the typical visitor, the NPS boasts 19 different park designations. These include:

# Method

### Collecting Data

For this report, a *recreation visit* occurs and is counted when "one person enters onto lands or waters administered by the NPS except as defined above for non-reportable and non-recreation visits". The rule is that "one entrance per individual per day is countable".

A *reportable non-recreation visit* occurs when a person travels to and from inholdings – privately owned land within a national park, when a person uses a service-administered road or waterway through a park for convenience, when a tradesperson has business in the park, when a person is pursuing gainful occupation – e.g. guides – within a park, when a government employee has business in the park, when a person uses NPS buildings for civic or local government business, or when outside researchers are pursuing work independent from NPS legislated interest – e.g. for meteorological research.

A *non-reportable visit* occurs whenever an NPS employee, an NPS employee's family member, concession employees, member of cooperating associations, NPS contractors, or service personnel enter the park.

Examples of non-reportable visits include NPS employees assigned to the park or visiting the park regarding a duty assignment, household members of personnel residing in the park, private tenants – inholders -- within NPS boundaries, persons engaged in pursuit of specific legal rights of use like subsistence hunting and fishing.

### Representing Data

Once the data representing 2019 recreation visits is collected it is arranged into a table. See Table 1.

Table 1 ranks each park by total recreation visits. It also illustrates the parks location, designation, and percentage of park recreation visits in comparison to 2019's total recreation visits.

From the data represented in Table 1, four charts were created. Each chart represents important information implicit in Table 1.

Chart 1, represented as a pie chart, illustrates the relationship between recreational visits and park type.

Chart 2, represented as another pie chart, illustrates the relationship between the amount of a certain park type amid all 19 park designations.

Chart 3, represented as a map, illustrates the relationship between recreational visits and their state of occurrence.

Note – The map does not include information on recreational visits to parks in Washington DC, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, or the US Virgin Islands. Applicable and important notes on parks and recreational visits will be provided with the chart.

Chart 4, also represented as a map, illustrates the relationship between states and the national park members they host.

Note – The map does not include information on recreational visits to parks in Washington DC, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, or the US Virgin Islands. Applicable and important notes on parks and recreational visits will be provided with the chart.

### Further Notes

Table 1 illustrates Recreational Visits by park, park designation, park location, and percentage. In this table, sometimes two parks are represented by a single entry.

For example, Aniakchak National Monument and Aniakchak National Preserve are represented by the single-entry of 1000 recreational visits. While the NPS records Aniakchak National Preserve and Aniakchak National Monument as two separate parks, their RV data is recorded as a single entry.

For ease and readability, Table 1 has been divided into 9 sections. Each section illustrates 50 entries. Table 1 illustrates the list of parks – 378 in total – that recorded recreational visitors in 2019. Entries are ranked by total recreational visits




Chart 1 – Recreational Visits by Park Type




Chart 2 – Percentage of Parks by Type




Chart 3 – Percentage of Recreational Visits by State

The blue-gradient bar to the right of the map illustrates the percentage of recreational visits by state. For example, 0% of recreational visits to National Parks happened in Delaware. 9.08% of recreational visits to national parks happened in California.

Note – This chart does not include information from the following locations: Washington DC (11.82% of RVs in 2019), Puerto Rico (0.27%), Guam (0.1%), the US Virgin Islands (0.06%), and American Samoa (0.01%). In 2019 no there were no recorded recreational visits to National Trails.

Note – For NPS members belonging to more than one state/ territory, the recreational visits were divided by the amount of locations sharing the park. For example, The Blue Ridge Parkway (BRP) runs through North Carolina and Virginia so recreational visits to the BRP were divided between North Carolina and Virginia.




Chart 4 – Percentage of National Parks by State

Chart 4 illustrates the relationship between the American states and the NPS parks within their borders.

The blue-gradient bar to the right of the map illustrates the percentage of parks within a state. For example, Delaware has 0% of the National Parks recording recreational visits in 2019. New York has 5.43% of National Parks recording recreational visits in 2019.

Note – This chart does not include information from the following locations: Washington DC (5.68% of NP recording RVs in 2019), the US Virgin Islands (0.99%), Puerto Rico (0.25%), Guam (0.25%), and American Samoa (0.25%).

Note – For NPS members belonging to more than one state/ territory, the park is counted for both states. For example, The Blue Ridge Parkway (BRP) runs through North Carolina and Virginia so both North Carolina and Virginia are recorded as home to the BRP.

# Analysis

- In 2019, the NPS recorded 327,516,619 recreational visits.
- Three parks recorded over 10 million recreational visits: Golden Gate National Recreation Area, Blue Ridge Parkway, and Great Smoky Mountains National Park.
- 11 parks recorded over five million recreation visits
- 80 parks recorded over one million recreation visits.
- 25 National Parks recorded over 1 million recreational visits.
- 50% of total recreation visits occurred in 27 parks.
- Washington DC recorded the most recreational visits in the United States.
- Washington DC has the most parks of any state or territory.
- The largest number of parks are National Historic Sites, 18% of all NPS parks.
- National Parks recorded the most recreational visits by park type with 26.85% of RVs.
